The Revive project is Homefinder UK's latest specialist service. The project focuses on finding new homes for domestic abuse survivors in a new and safe environment in a different part of the country.


Homefinder UK is a national mobility scheme which brings social housing applicants, properties and landlords together in one portal.

#### Case Study

## Three weeks to move out of a refuge

A young mother and her son fled domestic abuse and were placed in a refuge by the local authority. She registered with Homefinder UK, because her tenancy with the refuge was coming to an end. When we began working with her, she had less than three weeks to secure housing. We worked with the refuge and the housing association to secure a two-bed house in North East of England for her.

The biggest success here was that the applicant moved into her Housing Association property within 2 weeks of her referral to Homefinder UK, giving her more security with her tenancy and support from their tenancy sustainment service. The mother is now in employment, the son is in nursery and both are doing well.
