

## **Revive Scotland**

A new move-on service for women experiencing domestic abuse

Revive Scotland aims to support women experiencing domestic in abuse finding a new home away from their existing local authority area, whilst providing wrap around support to make sure that they settle into their new home, feel safe and look forward to a fresh start. Revive Scotland will work with Local Authorities, RSL's and Domestic Abuse Services across Scotland to ensure a smooth transition from one area to another.

Revive Scotland is an expansion of Homefinder UK's move-on service for domestic abuse survivors, Revive. This project was launched by Homefinder UK, in partnership with Wheatley Group, funded by The Scottish Government and administered by SFHA.



## Our dedicated team will:

- Support applicants throughout the moving process and assess their housing needs
- Work closely with Homelessness teams and Housing options services to help process each case and ensure a quick and smooth transition to a new home in a new area
- Work closely with Housing Associations or Landlords to identify and secure permanent social housing for domestic abuse victims/survivors and their families
- Provide tailored wraparound support options
- Signpost to other agencies, organisations and services required, to make sure applicants get all the support they need
- Offer follow up support and obtain customer satisfaction feedback on the service
