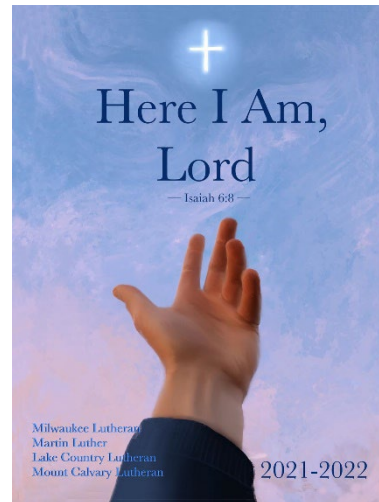

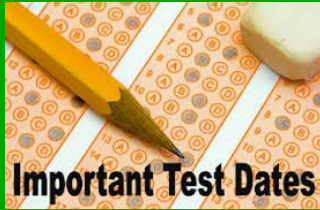

AP EXAM REGISTRATION OPEN FOR AP ENGLISH LANGUAGE STUDENTS!

It's not too late to register for full year courses (with a late fee), through 3/15/2022!

AP EXAMS will take place May 2-6 & May 9-13, 2022

Key Dates/Details:

- All students should add themselves to their AP course rosters (even if they're not planning to take the exam). This can be done in class using your account on MyAP.CollegeBoard.org. Contact your teacher for the Join Code.
- **2/7/2022: AP English Language exam registration begins (this is offered as a 2nd sem. course only at ML)** – students received registration info on Monday, February 7.
- **3/14: AP English Language exam registration ends**
- **3/15: Deadline for late fee registration for full year courses** – College Board fee of \$40 PLUS cost of exam (\$96) = \$136

Details:

- **Late registration:** Exam fee is \$96, plus \$40 late fee; \$136 total. **\$80 down payment** is required to cover cost of each exam. Remaining balance due by **3/15/2022**.
- **AP English Language** exam fee is \$96. **\$40 down payment** is required to cover cost of each exam. Remaining balance due by **3/14/2022**.
- We will accept e-Funds, cash, check or money order (made payable to Martin Luther High School) payment in Student Services.
- **Fee reduction of \$43** for students who qualify based on family financial circumstances. Parent must contact Mr. Kirk Langenkamp, AP Coordinator, at KLangenkamp@MartinLutherHS.org. Will reduce cost PER EXAM down to **\$93 exam fee** (including late fee) for full year courses, or down to **\$53 exam fee** for AP English Language only.

Students are expected to take the exam on the regularly scheduled CollegeBoard exam date. Any requests for late testing, or an alternate date due to athletic contest, academic event should be made well in advance of the regularly scheduled exam date.

As a reminder, it is open enrollment time. If you have not already done so, it is important that you complete your choice paperwork as soon as possible. Open enrollment does close Feb. 21st and if you do not complete your paperwork before then, your student will lose that seat. We want to make sure that does not happen. We are thrilled you are a part of the Spartan family.

Here are the necessary instructions to help you complete that paperwork.

You will need to re-log into the choice open enrollment application on the DPI website at:

Log in with the same email address and password that you used for the current school year. All of your data should still be there. Make any necessary changes to your personal information. Then you will need to click “edit” next to your student’s name to add Martin Luther High School as their school and connect your student to that school. Once you have confirmed everything, click submit and the data will be sent to Karla Miles, Choice Program Coordinator, at Martin Luther High School for verification.

What if a student is not feeling well??

This is just a reminder that if your student is not feeling well, they should stay home. If your student has a fever, they should not return to school until they have been fever free for 24 hours. Students who are absent because of illness need to have a parent/guardian contact the office via phone or email attendanceml@martinlutherhs.org to excuse your student for the day(s). You need to excuse your student for each day they are ill, please try to contact the office of any absences by 9am. Students who are not in attendance for the day can find their coursework on Schoology.

If your student becomes ill during the school day, a parent/guardian must contact the school office before the student can leave the building. Students who are leaving for illness during the day, should be picked up as soon as possible to lessen the spread of germs.

A reminder that masks are optional, if your student wears a mask, please know that Martin Luther will not be providing masks for students and visitors.



Severe Weather School Closure Alerts

If it is necessary to close school because of severe weather conditions, please watch for a ML email/text alert. Announcements will be made on local television (channels 4, 6 or 12). The web sites **todaystmj4.com**, **fox6now.com** and **wisn.com** will have a listing of all closings as well. When Milwaukee Public Schools close, Martin Luther will automatically close. When Greendale Public Schools close, Martin Luther will not necessarily close. The lack of an announcement means that school will be operating.

If school remains open and you feel that streets are too hazardous, please contact the school office, (414) 421-4000, to let us know if your child will be arriving late or not at all.
