ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- Completion of Australian Year 12 or equivalent; OR
- Certificate IV, VET Diploma or Higher Education Diploma; OR
- Successful Completion of one year of full time study in a degree course at a higher education provider; OR
- Admissions via non-academic criteria which may include demonstrated interest or experience in relevant fields of work. Students will be required to demonstrate this through a short written piece, interview and/or portfolio; AND
- Must be 17 years of age or older at time of commencement

COSTS

Students may choose to pay tuition fees upfront or in instalments.
