Why Partner with Generosity Path?

Our vision is that God's people will experience the words of Jesus – that it is more blessed to give than to receive – and become known around the world for their joyful sacrificial giving. To be clear, we do not want anything **from** your community; we want something **for** your community: a life filled with joy and peace, free from anxiety and fear; a life of open-handed generosity.

Our passion and love at Generosity Path is to help business owners, business leaders, and professionals accept Jesus' invitation to relationship and move onto a path of generosity with joyful anticipation. Because Generosity Path is fully and privately funded by a small group of private Christian donors, we don't fundraise at our events nor do we allow others to do so. This is a safe and unique opportunity for people to talk about money and possessions without any concern that there will be an appeal for funds.

Our prayer is that your givers become more sacrificially generous, giving exponentially more than they give today. Our prayer is that your ministry is unleashed to become all that God wants it to be.

What is a Journey of Generosity?

A Journey of Generosity is an overnight retreat for 10-20 givers focused on the joy of living generously. It includes stories of generous givers, interactive discussions, reflection opportunities, and Bible study that enables participants to process the biblical message of generosity. It is story-driven and experiential in nature. We do not teach or prescribe. Instead, we allow each participant the freedom to experience their unique journey with God around generosity.



What would it look like to partner with Generosity Path?

- 1** | Identify a point person from your organisation.
- 2** | Have your leadership team attend a Journey of Generosity.
- 3** | Designate your representatives to be trained as Journey of Generosity facilitators for your network.

Generosity Path will provide all of the training and materials to you at no cost. You and your team will handle the logistics and costs of each retreat. The Generosity Path team is available to answer any questions you have along the way. We request you register each JOG so we can ensure quality through our follow-up surveys, and so our givers can celebrate the impact of their investment.
