Project Successes: Oct–Dec 2021

The Department successfully completed six projects during the fourth quarter of 2021 -

two new business attractions, three business expansions and the retention of one business. The companies involved operate within several areas targeted by the county, namely, life sciences & biotechnology; federal contracting and corporate facilities. These six projects are expected to invest a total of \$6 million in the county and add 59 new jobs.
