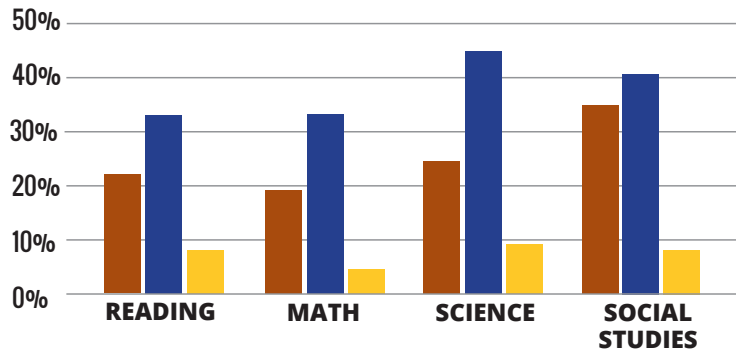

We have a crisis.

WHY?

There are ninety-five 80/80 K-8 schools in Milwaukee serving almost 31,000 students.

The average reading proficiency rate in these ninety-five 80/80 schools is 8.3%.

What's an 80/80 school?

80/80 schools are at least 80% African American and at least 80% low-income.

8.3% is half of the already low district-wide proficiency rate of 19% and a fifth of the state proficiency of 41%. Math scores are equally poor.

Our failure to educate low-income, African American children directly results in the nation's highest incarceration rates, massive spending on remediation, and, most tragically, violent crime and premature death.

WHAT'S THE SOLUTION?

Though district, charter, and voucher sectors are *all* failing, there are schools that consistently outperform the odds and give children bright futures like Milwaukee College Prep (MPS), LUMIN (MPCP), and St. Marcus Lutheran (MPCP).

We must work together to educate all children.

Expanding successful schools, no matter the sector, is the best way to create future leaders within Milwaukee.
