Booster shot recommended for certain groups of people

As you have likely heard in the news, we received great news last week from the Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC).

The CDC is now recommending that certain groups should receive a booster shot of Pfizer-BioNTech's COVID-19 Vaccine no sooner than six months after completing their Pfizer-BioNTech two-shot series.

These groups include:

- People aged 65 years of age or older
- Those living in long-term care settings
- Those with underlying medical conditions
- Those working in health care settings

It is important to note that the booster shot is not yet recommended for those who received the Moderna or Johnson and Johnson COVID-19 vaccine.

As with the previous rounds of vaccines for COVID-19, Otterbein will hold a series of clinics at each location as soon as possible for the Pfizer booster. The clinics will be in conjunction with our pharmacy partner, and will be open to all residents, elders, partners and contractors, regardless of level of care (and inclusive of residents in independent living).

We hope to have detailed information very soon about the schedule of clinics in your area, and will provide the schedule as soon as we can.



The “Delta” variant of the COVID-19 virus is now prevalent throughout the United States.

The pandemic is not over and we must continue to be vigilant in adhering to protocols designed for the safety of residents, partners, and their respective families. Isolation and quarantines can be onerous on ourselves, our families and friends.

If you or your loved one is unvaccinated, we ask that you reconsider and get vaccinated.

For residents that are able to go out into the community we recommend that you reach out to local Walgreen; Rite Aid or CVS pharmacies until we are able to set up specific dates for our clinics that will be located at each of our Otterbein locations.
