
Soft sterile dressing made of Calcium Sodium Alginate fibers

How to use Melgisorb® Plus




1. Select a size of Melgisorb® Plus that is slightly larger than the wound. Open the package by pulling.



2. Apply a dry Melgisorb® Plus product to the moist wound bed.

Shallow wounds: Choose the correct dressing size to cover the entire wound.

Deep wounds and cavities: Cut the appropriate length of the cavity dressing and loosely fill the wound.



 Cover and secure Melgisorb® Plus with an appropriate secondary dressing such as Mepilex® Border or Alldress®.

Compression therapy may be used in conjunction with Melgisorb® Plus.

How Melgisorb® Plus works

Melgisorb® Plus absorbs large amounts of wound exudate. When absorbing, the alginate fibers become gel-like providing a moist environment conducive to wound healing. The dressing can easily be removed by irrigating with 0.9% normal saline.

Benefits of Melgisorb® Plus

- Highly absorbent^{1,2,3}
- Does not adhere to the wound site when gelled^{1,2,3}
- Suitable for cavity wound^{1,2,6}
- Dressing becomes gel-like on contact with exudate or solutions^{1,2,3} containing sodium ions (saline)
- Soft/ pliable/ conformable 1,2,3
- Can be cut to shape⁴
- Non-sensitizing⁵

Change Rate

Change Melgisorb® Plus dressing when saturation is reached. Melgisorb® Plus can be left in place for several days depending on wound condition or as indicated by clinical practice.

Precautions

Melgisorb® Plus is not indicated for dry wounds, third degree burns or surgical implantations.

If infection is suspected, follow facility treatment guidelines.
