Equity Information Exchange Introduced as a Solution to Health Disparities in Minority Communities

CareAdvisors took action when it was clear that an already-significant data gap in health information access was widening during the COVID-19 pandemic. The company introduced an equity information exchange (EIEx) that combines all the information that allows healthcare providers to securely share a patient's medical information through a

health information exchange and combines that with the human services data available in a community information exchange (ie., services, such as food, housing, and transportation).

Ease of use and broad access to resources was the key driver for CareAdvisors when developing the EIEx. Focused on its health equity mission, the company has taken an open source approach to its EIEx, which is hosted by the non-profit CareAdvisors Software Foundation. The EIEx offers data across platforms, regardless of a healthcare organization's social service e-referral system or electronic health record vendor.
