
What is KW Prep?

Pre-Licensure/CE Eligible:

Alabama, Arizona, Arkansas, California, Colorado, Florida, Georgia, Iowa, Illinois, Kentucky, Michigan, Minnesota, Missouri, Nevada, New Mexico, New York, North Carolina, Pennsylvania, South Carolina, Tennessee, Texas, Virginia, Washington, Wisconsin

CE-Only Eligible:

Connecticut, New Jersey, Ohio, Oregon

When will this program launch and where is it available?

- **Pre-Licensure/CE States:** Market centers within the 24 states indicated in the heat map can enroll immediately. Student enrollment, along with access to an education portal for agents to access pre-licensure and continuing education courses, will begin November 1. Students are able to access continuing education at a reduced rate. Students will have to connect with a participating market center to enroll.
- **CE-Only States:** Market centers in CE-only states will receive access to an education portal where currently licensed KW agents can purchase continuing education at a reduced rate starting Nov. 1.
- **KW Prep States:** Market centers that are not within the initial 24-state licensing territory can opt into KW Prep in November. The curriculum will be available in December.

How will instruction be delivered for the Keller Williams School of Real Estate?

- Pre-Licensure/CE States: Courses will be offered in an online, self-study format. Instructor-led courses will be available at an additional cost to the student.
- CE-Only States: CE courses will also be delivered by our education partner via a digital portal.
- KW Prep States: Via a digital learning platform managed by KWU.

How do I sign up as a student?

PRICING

What is the pricing structure for the Keller Williams School of Real Estate?

- Pre-Licensure/CE States: Market centers in licensure-eligible states can bring on unlimited students for a low monthly subscription fee and receive an additional promo if signing on by December 1. The cost of real estate school is FREE to students.
- **CE-Only States:** Market centers in CE-only states are able to offer agents continuing education via the student portal delivered to them on November 1. If enrolled in the KW Prep program by December 1, market centers will also receive a promo. Students will pay for their CE courses.
- **KW Prep States:** Market centers in states where pre-licensure and continuing education are not available can access the KW Prep program for a low monthly subscription. Enrollment opens in November with program delivery coming in December. KW Prep is FREE to students.
