Tips for Culturally Responsive Teaching

Tip #1:

Ask students to relate their own experiences to those of the characters in the course. What is similar or different?



Tip #2:

What messages do they get from their family, friends, the media regarding the topics covered in the course?



Tip #3:

Connect the lesson to your students' interests and cultures. If you aren't sure, survey them.



Tip #4:

After the lesson, get your students' feedback on what they liked and/or resonated with?



Tip #5:

After the lesson, get your students' feedback on what they did not like or want to see differently in the future?



Tip #6:

Include discussion in small groups and large groups to center student voices after they take the courses.
