WHAT WILL YOU LEARN IN THIS PROGRAM?

Nexus University's Doctorate of Nursing Practice (DNP) program at Nexus University is designed to prepare nurses to assume leadership roles incorporating advanced clinical expertise, quality improvement methods, patient safety and care technology, health care policy for advocacy, and health system changes. Through scientific theory, evidence-based practice, information technology and practicum experiences, we facilitate the development of well-prepared nurse leaders.

Graduates can enter strategic leadership positions that will impact healthcare outcomes of individuals and populations. The merging of practical knowledge with organizational systems, healthcare policy, interprofessional collaboration, population health and leadership experience allow graduates to contribute to the transformation of healthcare.

The program of study is completed in 6 sequential semesters. Each semester contains two 8-week sessions and students take a maximum of 3 credit hours per 8-week session. The students will complete 250 practicum hours in each of the practicum courses for a total of 1,000 practical hours. The program's instructional modality includes 100% online for theory course content and the practicum experiences will be in a healthcare facility. The core courses must be completed before the practicum courses can be started.

DNP QUICK FACTS

Here are a few key things to know about being a DNP, according to NurseJournal.org¹.

- The DNP is the highest level of education available in the field of nursing.
- DNP-holders enjoy higher salaries than nurses with BSNs and MSNs, earning an average of \$104,489/year².
- Top-paying DNP positions include chief nursing officer (\$151,000/year on average).
- DNP programs teach higher-level skills in nursing practice and DNPs strive to improve patient outcomes.
- DNP-holders often take leadership positions in large healthcare organizations or facilities. Some also work as expert clinicians or secure academic positions that emphasize clinical practice and education.

REDUCING THE COST OF YOUR DEGREE

Nexus University has several options for reducing the cost of your education. These include scholarships, transfer credits and fixed monthly payments. Our monthly payment plan is a private education loan with 0% fixed interest (0% APR) and no money down, with payments from just \$375/month.*

Not everyone will be eligible for cost-reduction options, so please contact an admissions representative to discuss your questions and see if you qualify.



* Reduced Installment Plan: The student can opt to pay a \$375 interest-free monthly payment based on the program of choosing; when applicable (depending on duration of the program), the monthly payment will increase 20% yearly. The student can elect to pay more when possible. The student must pay the total program commitment before graduation. No additional fees apply.

ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Master of Science in Nursing from an accredited institution.
- 2. Current, active and unrestricted professional licensure in Florida.
- 3. Minimum Graduate cumulative grade point average (CGPA) of 3.0 (4.0 scale)
- 4. Applicants with earned credits from a foreign institution of higher education must have their credential and/or courses validated, translated and certified by a NACES approved agency and submit copies of original transcript and translation.
- 5. The Graduate Record Exam (GRE) is NOT required.
- 6. Professional CV or resume with evidence of the equivalent of 12 months of full-time nursing practice within the last two years.

ADMISSIONS PROCESS

- 1. Complete the Nexus University application and submit with a nonrefundable application fee of \$50.
- 2. Submit Official Transcripts from all higher education institutions. Submit official transcripts to:

Submit verification of current, active and unrestricted RN licensure in Florida.

The DNP program does not prepare graduates for licensure as an RN or APRN. Students enrolled in the DNP program are required to maintain a current, active and unrestricted professional nursing licensure throughout the program.

DEGREE REQUIREMENTS

A student needs to complete the 36 graduate semester credits required in the program. In order to achieve the DNP competencies, the DNP program has a minimum of 1,000 hours of practice postbaccalaureate as part of a supervised academic program as required by the Essentials of Doctoral Education for Advanced Nursing Practice from the American Association of Colleges of Nursing (2006).
