



Career Scholarship for MSN Program

Nexus University is proud to offer three (3) Career Scholarships. These scholarships will be awarded to three (3) new students per cohort. These scholarships are in keeping with our mission to form professionals through educational experiences that stimulate ethical behavior, as well as an attitude of enterprise, innovation, leadership, and respect for cultural and social diversity.

ELIGIBILITY

- Scholarship applicants must apply to and start the MSN program at Nexus University School of Health Sciences and Nursing.
- Scholarship applicants must meet all admissions requirements of Nexus University.
- The scholarship is non-transferrable to any other program or person.
- The scholarship is non-combinable to any other Nexus University internal scholarships.
- Scholarship applicant must not be a current Nexus University student.
- Scholarship applicant must not have vested in a previous Nexus University program without graduating.
- Scholarship applicant must take a minimum of six (6) credits per session to maintain eligibility.
- Scholarship applicant must sustain a minimum of 2.5 GPA per session/semester to maintain eligibility.
- Scholarship only applies to program core courses.
- Scholarship applicants must submit a Career Scholarship application and essay after completing at least 80% of the Nexus University student application.
- Career scholarships will be awarded to eligible students on a first come first served basis after meeting the criteria listed above.

ESSAY SUBMISSION AND REQUIREMENTS

- Please answer each essay question using no less of 200 words and no more of 500 words.
- Scholarship application along with essay must be submitted to registrar@nexusuniversity.com.

- Career scholarships are limited, consequently, application and essay must be submitted promptly.
- Each essay question must be original work. Quotations or attributions must be cited.

SELECTION PROCESS

- The recipients of this Scholarship will be selected by the Nexus University Scholarship Committee consisting of representatives from Nexus University. Non-faculty members may assist in the selection committee process.
- It is the applicant's responsibility to submit a completed essay, which must be received along with scholarship application. Nexus University selection committee accepts no responsibility for incomplete essays, essays not in proper form, lost essays, or any other submission in exception to the instructions.
- The Scholarship award will be based on the committee's selection of submitted essays.
- The decision of the scholarship selection committee is final and not subject to a review process.
- Nexus University and its employees, officers, directors, affiliates, agents, and representatives are not responsible for any typographical or other errors in the offer or administration of the [scholarship/grant/award], including, but not limited to, errors in any printing or posting of these terms and conditions, the selection and announcement of any awardee, or the distribution of any Career Scholarship. AWARDS

- The three (3) Career Scholarships are a USD \$3,500 value scholarship that will be awarded to three (3) new students.
- Career scholarships will be awarded to eligible students on a first come first served basis after meeting the criteria listed above.
- The awardee, the submission or portions thereof may be posted to the Nexus University website and used in Nexus University promotional materials.
- The Scholarship has no cash value.
- Scholarships that are awarded to the recipients may only be used to assist with the payment of their tuition in Nexus University's MSN program and are not redeemable in cash.
- No student will receive more than one Career Scholarship.
- No student will receive more than one offers such as scholarships, grants, technology awards, tuition reduction, or preferred tuition rates.
- If a recipient is selected for more than one scholarship, the recipient may choose which scholarship to be applied to their tuition. The forfeited scholarship will then go to the next selected eligible applicant.
- The Scholarship does not include the costs of any fees or courses other than the program core courses. Students are still financially responsible to cover the costs of these fees and courses throughout their program.

- Any Scholarship funds that are awarded may not be used for the purchase of books, any fees that may be applicable to their degree program, and outside materials (computers, internet service, etc.).
- Any courses accepted as transfer from another school to a Nexus University degree plan will only reduce the necessary coursework required to complete a degree at Nexus University and will not result in any additional unused scholarship funds.
- Any tuition paid prior to the scholarship award will be refunded to the awardee within 30 days, if applicable.
- In the event the program does not start, the awarded scholarship will be transfer to the next start date.
- Courses taken under the Scholarship may be recorded against the student's calendar year 1098-T.

MAINTAINING ELIGIBILITY

- All existing student policies located in the Nexus University catalog must be adhered to while the recipient is a student at Nexus University.
- For the duration of the award, students must be succeeding in their degree program and maintaining at least a 2.5 GPA in all sessions/semesters. The student must maintain a Satisfactory Academic Standard (SAS). Please see the current catalog for SAS definition.
- For the duration of the award, students must be taking six (6) credits per session.
- Should a Scholarship recipient withdraw or be dismissed from Nexus University prior to disbursement of all Scholarship funds awarded to him or her, the balance of the tuition funds awarded, but not disbursed, will be terminated and will not be available to the student for future courses.
- If a Scholarship recipient withdraws from a course or receives a non-passing grade, the student will no longer eligible for the carrier scholarship. The student will be solely responsible of the cost to take or retake a course.

- Applicants must submit the Essay in a Microsoft Word document.
- The Essay must be typed, double-spaced, on one side of white 8½ by 11-inch (letter size) paper with left and right margins at 1¼ inches each. Font must be no smaller than 12-point Times or similarly sized font.
- The Essay must have a title and page numbers.
- The Essay must have no more than 1,000 words.
- The Essay must be original work. Quotations or attributions must be cited.
- Use standardized method and style such as APA to consistently give credit to the sources of the ideas and information used in the essay.
- Applicants must submit the Essay to admissions@nexusuniversity.com .
- Only one Essay may be submitted by an applicant.
