



## RED PINE

Red Pine and Southern Yellow Pine are the two primary species that are treated and used for fencing. Southern Yellow has been the primary species for decades. Now Red Pine is more readily available for fencing and has distinct benefits over Southern Yellow Pine.

**Surfacing:** Rough both faces | Smooth 1 face and Rough 1 face

**Standard Topping:** Dog Ear | Flat Top

**4ft Height Fence Topping:** Gothic | French Gothic

**Grading:** #2 and better
