COMPETITION RULES & REGULATIONS

TABLE TENNIS

1 General Rules

- 1.1 According to the latest Rules and Regulations of the International Table Tennis Federation (ITTF).
- 1.2 Competition shall be subjected to requirements stipulated under the latest Safe Management Measures advisory issued by SportSG. Competition may be postponed, suspended or cancelled following the guidelines of the advisory.

2 Events, Eligibility & Registration Fees

2.1 Events

2.2 Age Eligibility

2	Girls' Singles (12 & Under)	born between 1 Jan 2010 and 31 Dec 2015
3	Boys' Singles (15 & Under)	born between 1 Jan 2007 and 31 Dec 2015
4	Girls' Singles (15 & Under)	born between 1 Jan 2007 and 31 Dec 2015
5	Masters Women's Singles 35+	born on or before 31 Dec 1987
6	Masters Men's Singles 40-54	born between 1 Jan 1968 and 31 Dec 1982
7	Masters Men's Singles 55+	born on or before 31 Dec 1967

2.3 Only the following are eligible to participate:

2.3.1 fully vaccinated individuals who have received the appropriate regimen of World Health Organisation Emergency Use Listing (WHO EUL) vaccines including their respective duration post-vaccination for the vaccine to be fully effective and had their vaccination records ingested in MOH's national IT systems, and

2.3.2 those who have recovered from COVID-19.

3 Event Venue & Schedule

3.1 All matches will be held at ActiveSG Jurong West Sport Centre, Level 4 Table Tennis Room. The detailed schedule is as follows:

Note: The above schedule is subjected to change once the entries are finalised. Competition might start earlier or later.

4 Competition Format

4.1 Competition will be played in 2 stages:

4.1.1 Stage 1

- Entries will be drawn and grouped into groups for each event.
- Matches will be played in a group round robin format, all matches to be decided by best of 3 games of 11 points.
- Top 2 from each group will progress to Stage 2.
- At this stage, all matches are self-officiated. Organisers shall only provide administrative staff to record match points and results.

4.1.2 Stage 2

- Top 2 from each group will then be drawn into a single elimination format to determine the position.
- All matches are to be decided by best of 5 games of 11 points

4.1.3 The group final ranking (ladder standing position) shall be determined by the number of matches/ties won. However in the event of a tie, the following shall apply (in sequence) to determine the position:

- i) Match score win/loss ratio
- ii) Games win/loss ratio
- iii) Points win/loss ratio
- iv) If standings are still tied after the first 3 tabulations, the position will be decided by lot.

5 **Medals**

5.1 Medals will be awarded to the top 3 positions of each event.

5.2 In the event that there are less than 4 entries for an event, organisers have the right to cancel the event or allow participants to join another category which they are eligible for.

6 **Walkover**

6.1 Participants(s) are required to report 15 minutes before match time.

6.2 Participant(s) shall concede a walkover if they fail to be present on court when the match is called to play. There shall be no grace period.

7 **Supplementary Rules**

7.1 Each player is allowed to register only **one (1) Singles event**.

7.2 All players are requested to produce their Identity Card for registration on the day of the competition.

7.3 The ITTF approved 3-Star 40+ mm **white** balls shall be used during the Tournament. No **white** apparels or clothing (shirt and shorts) are allowed. Players who fail to conform shall be disqualified.

7.4 The Prize Presentation Ceremony shall be held soon after the finals of the events. All prize winners **MUST** be present personally at the ceremony in neat attire (no singlet, slippers and sandals) in order to receive the prize. Failing which, the Organising Committee reserves the right not to award the medal and trophy.

- 7.5 Registration deadline is on **10 March 2022**.
- 7.6 Draw shall be conducted on **14 March 2022** by the referee team, witnessed by ActiveSG Staff and Technical team.
- 7.7 All players are required to sign an indemnity form prior to their participation in the competition.
- 7.8 In the event of any dispute, the match shall be played under protest. The Organising Committee shall determine the matter on receipt of the protest in writing, together with a protest fee (amount as stated in the General Rules & Regulations of ActiveSG Quarterly Competition, March 2022), within one hour after the match. The decision of the Organising Committee shall be final and there shall be no further appeal.
- 7.9 The Organising Committee has the rights to include, amend or exclude any of the above terms and conditions without any prior notice.
