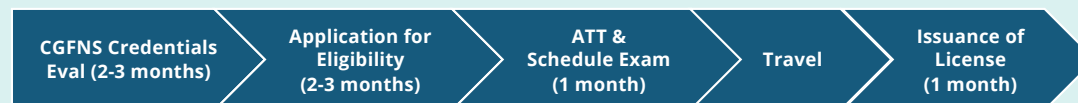

FAQ NCLEX Program

How long is the NCLEX program?

The full time NCLEX review program takes 20 days to complete. The part-time program will extend over a longer period depending on availability.

The 20–25-day refresher course, is done 30-45 days prior to taking the NCLEX.

How long do I have to complete the NCLEX predictor test?

The link for you to login and complete the predictor test will be available for 10 consecutive days. If you haven't completed it after 7 days, we will send you a reminder and close your application on the 10th day.

Do I have to complete the predictor test all at once? Can I logout and complete it later?

Yes, please ensure that you have good internet connection and that you set aside 1-2hrs to complete the predictor test.

During the predictor test, can I have multiple windows open?

We recommend closing all internet tabs before logging in the predictor test. We also recommend that you use Google Chrome or Firefox Mozilla as your browser for the predictor. If you have a problem logging in, you may email info@ragapuzreview.com with the subject CONEXUS Predictor Problem: (Username), if necessary, we will be rescheduling your predictor.

How long will it take for me to know the results of my NCLEX predictor test?

In Partnership with RA Gapuz, Conexus will review your results and contact you within 8-10 business days after your completion of the predictor test.



FAQ NCLEX Program (Cont'd)

What if I'm not successful with the predictor test, can I re-take it? Will I know my score?

The predictor test is a 1-time test. If for some reason you are not successful, we encourage you to take the NCLEX before re-applying.

Are all classes online?

You do need a laptop or desktop computer and wi-fi to attend and complete these classes. Due to Covid-restrictions, all our classes are online (live). If you are in the Philippines and the Government allows face-to-face classes, they will be held on Gapuz branches — Manila, Baguio, Cebu, and Davao and will follow all Covid-related restrictions. We can have a class at Conexus' head office in Manila.

What if I'm in a different time zone?

We regularly host classes for students in the Philippines, Middle East, Kenya and nearby African nations, and the UK. If there's enough student situated in the same time zone, we can customize a review schedule for these students.

Do I have to attend all classes?

We recommend that you attend all classes. According to our data, the passing rate is as high as 80%-90% for those who completed the program.

What if I am unable to attend a class? Is there a limit on how many I can miss?

We can arrange for a make-up class for the subject you missed, it will be a replay of the class and it is a video recording. If you miss 40% of the class we recommend you repeat the program with the next batch of reviewers.

FAQ NCLEX Program (Cont'd)

How much will this cost me? Do I need to repay Conexus for their investment?

Conexus is offering a full NCLEX sponsorship program which means that Conexus will cover the costs of your NCLEX review program, licensure and travel to and from the testing center.

What if I need a passport and/or a visa to travel to the country where I'm scheduled to take the NCLEX?

It is your responsibility to apply for a passport and if required, secure a tourist visa for the country in which your NCLEX has been scheduled for.

How long will it take for me to receive my ATT to be able to sit the NCLEX?

Depending on the state, the average processing time is 5-8 months from the moment the application is complete.

What if I fail the NCLEX?

If you're committed to the program and dedicate yourself to studying, we are confident you will pass your NCLEX. However, if for some reason you aren't successful, Conexus only covers the costs for your 1st attempt. Should you wish to re-take the exam, it is your responsibility to cover the associated costs.

When will Conexus start my immigration process?

As soon as you pass your NCLEX and your license is issued we will initiate your immigration process.
