Our village hall and community building survey (2021) showed us that a significant number of village halls (28%) have reported some loss of activities from their building as a result of COVID-19, either due to attendee nervousness or due to providers taking the delivery of their activities online. In response to this we want to help and support village halls and community buildings as much as possible to rebuild back to the levels of activity they experienced before the pandemic.
